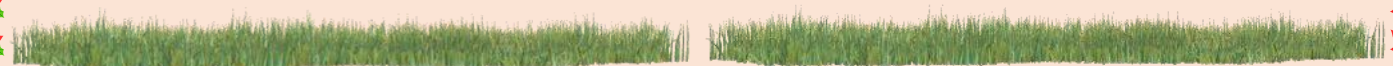

CHILD LABOUR

Child labour is a term you might have heard about in news or movies. It refers to a crime where children are forced to work from a very early age. 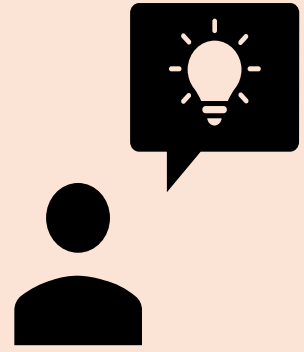
